

## Articulating your vision – Worksheet

Your vision is an image of what God has already finished and given you the privilege of manifesting on earth . A God given vision is not a fabrication of our minds. A God given vision is a redemptive revelation of God. It is an image of the finished work of God yet to be manifested on earth. When Abraham believed the vision God gave him of children as much as the sand on the seashore and the stars in the sky, He was not believing in a vision that was just being fabricated in response to the circumstances of his life. He was believing in a vision that was a revelation of the completed work of redemption.

### **Some obstacles to seeing and manifesting your vision**

1. A lack of Clarity
2. Indecision
3. Unfounded or empty positivity. Positivity that isn't backed by concrete deliberate action.
4. Failure to identify your helpers
5. The trap of busyness
6. Lack of personal responsibility

### **Questions for reflection.**

When you are at your best, what do you see in your future?

Do you have the guts to believe in what you see? **Faith is the audacity to believe in the images, the visions induced by God's Word.**

Why is it necessary to have a vision that serves much more than your own needs?

What demand is your vision placing on you?

**Action/Prayer points.**

- What scripture will you say captures the hopes and expectations you have of your life? (long term or short term)
- Write down the image you see what you read that scripture
- Write a list of the demands that your vision will place on you, identifying which one's you have been attending to and which one's need more attention.
- Ask the Lord to give you clarity, wisdom, insight, favour and the tenacity to stay the course.
- What is the next thing you need to do to walk closer to that God given vision?
